Scriptural Confessions For Pregnancy and Delivery

Heavenly Father, I thank You for the fruit of the womb and the privilege of bringing Your baby, [baby's prophetic name], into the world (Psalm 127:3).

I thank You that You are the Lord, my shepherd. Therefore, my body will not be in want of all it needs to carry this pregnancy till the appointed time and baby [baby's prophetic name] will not be in want of all s/he needs for full and appropriate development (Psalm 23:1).

According to Your Word in Galatians 1:15, at the perfect time, when it pleases You, You will separate baby [baby's prophetic name] from my womb. Therefore, I line up with Your Word and declare that I shall not suffer miscarriage and the number of my days You will fulfil (Exodus 23:26). Baby [baby's prophetic name] will be born at the time You have ordained.

Father, I thank You that Your thoughts towards baby [baby's prophetic name] and me are of good and not evil, but to bring us to an expected end (Jeremiah 29:11). My dear heavenly Father, I give You all the praise and glory for I know that just as You separated me from my mother's womb and have upheld me from birth (Psalm 71:6), You will do the same for baby [baby's prophetic name]. Thank You, Lord, for perfecting all that concerns me during this pregnancy through to baby [baby's prophetic name]'s delivery (Psalm 138:8).
